

**RESOLUTION EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO
GERMANTOWN HIGH SCHOOL and St. JOSEPH CATHOLIC CHURCH**

WHEREAS, the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, is a new municipality, its municipal incorporation having taken legal effect on June 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Gluckstadt being a new municipality in 2021 in great need of physical meeting space to hold its regular and special meetings of both its Board of Aldermen and its Zoning Commission, including certain public hearings related to zoning, the tax levy, and the adoption of two annual municipal budgets; and

WHEREAS, for the first seven months of its existence, and until January of 2022, Gluckstadt was without a City Hall which could regularly accommodate such public meetings required for the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, as well as the Zoning Commission, to conduct the City business legally; and

WHEREAS, both Germantown High School and St. Joseph Catholic Church did on many occasions from June through December 2021 provide meeting space at no cost to the City for all needed public meetings;

WHEREAS, only via this generous accommodation made by both Germantown High School and St. Joseph Catholic Church, was the City able to conduct its necessary and important city business, which was especially critical at this early stage of the City's existence; and

WHEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, as follows:

1. The City of Gluckstadt wishes to express its sincere appreciation to both Germantown High School and St. Joseph Catholic Church for the donation of meeting space for the City to conduct its public meetings.
2. Both Germantown High School and St. Joseph Catholic Church have greatly assisted the City of Gluckstadt and its citizens by providing the space for public meetings at times which accommodate both the City officials and the general public.
3. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, express their genuine appreciation for the assistance provided Germantown High School and St. Joseph Catholic Church during this time of transition following the legal incorporation of Gluckstadt.
