

**RESOLUTION FOR PAYMENT OF TAXES FOR THE
MAINTENANCE OF ROADS AND BRIDGES**

WHEREAS, the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, is a new municipality, its municipal incorporation having taken legal effect on June 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Gluckstadt being a new municipality in 2021 does not have the necessary staff or equipment to maintain roads and bridges within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, until such time that Gluckstadt has the staff and/or equipment to maintain roads and bridges within the municipality, Madison County will continue maintenance of roads and bridges within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, until such time that Gluckstadt assumes maintenance of roads and bridges, payments to Gluckstadt pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 65-15-21 cannot be made or accepted;

WHEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Gluckstadt, Mississippi, as follows:

1. Payment for the maintenance of roads and bridges pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 65-15-21 shall not be made, because the City of Gluckstadt does not maintain roads and bridges within the municipality.
2. The City of Gluckstadt will return any payments made pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 65-15-21 to Madison County.
3. The making of payment pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 65-15-21 is subject to change at such time that the City of Gluckstadt assumes maintenance of roads and bridges within the municipality.

SO RESOLVED this the 11th day of January 2022. Motion was made by Alderman Powell, and seconded by Alderman Slay, for the adoption of the above and foregoing Order.
